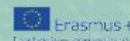

- 9 - Develop ICT and skills.
- 10 - Develop photography skills.
- 11 - Learn how to market a service or a product.

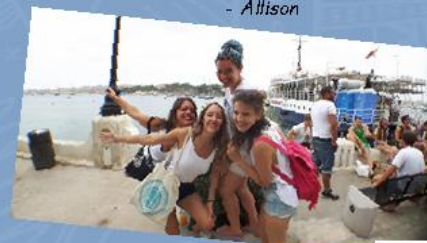
