Via the project, FoE groups will be organising a series of skill-sharing events for staff and volunteers on topics including climate justice, food sovereignty and extractive industries as well as mobilisation, communication, and organisational development. Other projects which FoE Malta will be working on in 2015 are the setting up of an Interpretation Centre on Comino, a Honeybees project (currently at the funding application stage) and a local 'Green' Arts and Film Festival which will be spread over 3 days and will showcase documentaries, feature films and shorts tackling environmental issues, will encourage young children and youths to observe, appreciate and be inspired by our natural heritage to create short clips and films.</p>

Name of Organisation	<b>Tghanniqa /0423</b>
Aims of Organisation	<p>We are a group of volunteers who offer our time, energy and ideas to help around 20 children and youths who make use of the Non-Governmental Organisation called Tghanniqa situated in Cospicua. Tghanniqa is a group of volunteers who have been supporting children in the Cottonera area coming from disadvantaged social and financial backgrounds by providing them with a community school, twice a week in the afternoon, all year round for the past eleven years. In winter we give our service users private lessons free of charge, where we help them with homework, reading, revision and life skills. We believe that all kids have the right to proper education and so we organise different interactive sessions during which we give children individual attention catering for their personal needs. The organization emphasizes upon creating an environment which promotes to our service users' a sense of belonging, whereby encouraging them to interact with volunteers (most of whom are youths), to create friendly relationships between the service users and the volunteers. Our service users' needs are assessed individually so that the service is tailor made according to each individual's abilities. On the other hand, in summer we offer them an afterschool summer school focusing on dancing, crafts, drama and script writing with the aim to set a talent show at the end of summer. Here, family and friends would have the opportunity to appreciate these kids' work, while at the same time meet our volunteers. As part of Tghanniqa's annual time-table, various activities are organized for children including health days, sport days and cultural outings, as well as parties and fun activities for all to enjoy. Moreover Tghanniqa has offered a number of seminars for parents including talks by experts in fields of health, dentistry, nutrition, money management and also provided the parents with the opportunity of doing the Food Handling Course to increase the parents' employability. Another important service, offered by Tghanniqa is the distribution of resources such as clothes, books, shoes and food to the families in need. Over half of our service users have been</p>

	<p>with us for the past six years. This has helped us to build a healthy, trusting relationship and as they grow up, some feel the need to start doing voluntary work themselves. Currently we have four past service users who have taken up the roles of volunteers and thus Tgħanniqa is also empowering community members to start becoming community leaders themselves. Additionally, Tgħanniqa also helped some children who have been under care order, and are now living in state homes for children. Here Tgħanniqa offered its support and facilitated the transition process for these children and kept regular contact with all of them. Tgħanniqa is a registered non-governmental organisation with the Malta Council for the Voluntary Sector and also with Aġenzija Żgħażaġħ. It is also a member of the Forum tal-Kommunita Bormliża. In 2012, we have been nominated for the Premju tal-President għall-volontarjat, and placed third. Moreover, Tgħanniqa is listed with the Directorate for Quality and Standards in Education and is in a position to support the service users by filling in the form they need, to help them with their School Leaving Certificate (SLC).</p>
Volunteer Work Proposed	<p>Work with children to help them with school work, reading and revision. Help to plan for a summer talent show. Prepare paper work including an online newsletter, uploading organisation photos etc.</p>
