TReP – Professional Training in Restorative Practice, is a project implemented by an international partnership established between SOS Malta, The Childhood Development Initiative (CDI), Partner Bulgaria Foundation, SGM Solutions & Global Media GmbH, Malta College of Arts Science and Technology and brains Shuttle. The project is funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union.

The objective of the project is to create and test a part-time online training course in Restorative Practices for a Level 5 Undergraduate Certificate which will provide professionals with additional tools and skills, to develop restorative responses to conflict, minimise the occurrence of aggressive, violent, bullying and other harmful behaviours and establish the social capital required to maintain effective and positive communities.
