'Collective for a European Civic Service'

The Malta Council for the Voluntary Sector hosted the launching of the project of the European Civic Service in Malta - a project

led by the 'Collective for a European Civic Service', from France, with whom MCVS is collaborating as a partnering organisation, along with other member states such as Italy, France and Austria. The aim of this project is to encourage youth volunteers to participate in a voluntary service both locally in their own country and in a European country through European Solidarity Corps funding. In Malta, the local aspect is already being realized through the Youth Voluntary Service which is managed by MCVS. Moreover, by obtaining the Lead quality label, MCVS will also be able to start hosting European volunteers supporting a number of different local VOs in 2023. Starting the journey for the European Civic Service in October 2022 are YMCA Malta and Agenzija Sapport who will be hosting 2 ESC volunteers each.

The event was held under the patronage of the Hon. Julia Farrugia Portelli Portelli, Minister for Inclusion, Voluntary Organisations and Consumer Rights and the French Embassy in Malta represented by the Counsellor for Cooperation and Cultural Action, Mr. Renaud Lallement who also addressed the event. The event was addressed also by Mr. Benjamin Sibille, Founder and Director General of Collectif pour un service civique européen, France and Mr. Mauro Pace Parascandalo, CEO of the Malta Council for the Voluntary Sector, who launched officially the project.

Participating in the event, which was at the National Philharmonic Society La Vallette, Valletta, were representatives from the European Union Programs Agency – EUPA, YMCA – Malta, Agenzija Sapport, other Voluntary Organisations who are currently hosting Maltese youths under the local Youth Voluntary Service and European Youths presently in Malta through the European Solidarity Corps.


